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# STAR HAT

Lots of charities donate hats to people that really need them such as St Mungo's, Shelter, Knit For Peace and many refugee charities. This hat uses a simple texture that comes together into a star at the top.

## Yarn

James C Brett DK with Merino, 20%  
1 ball in shade DM30

## Needles

4mm needles

## Tension

24 sts and 34 rows to 10cm in diamond pattern on 4mm needles

## Dimensions

Circumference: 50cm  
Depth: 20cm

## PATTERN

Cast on 102 stitches

**Row 1:** K1, \*k2, p2 repeat from \* to last st, k1. Repeat this row 8 more times.

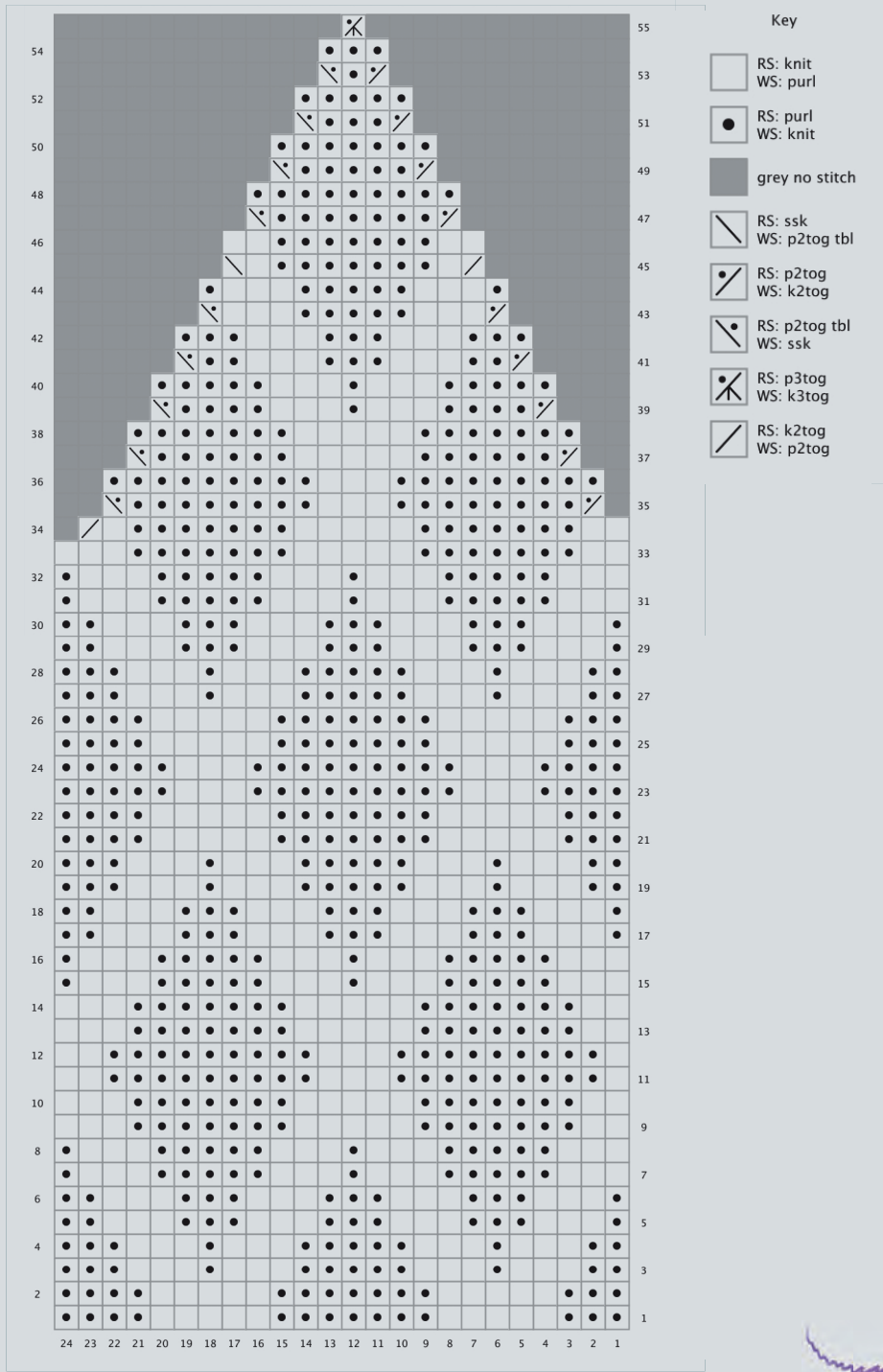
**Next row:** k1, \*k5, m1, repeat from \* until last stitch, k1 (122 sts)

Now begin working from the chart as follows

**Next row:** k1, work chart 5 times, k1

Continue working as described until row 55 of chart has been worked and 5 sts remain on the needle. Break yarn and thread through remaining sts, drawing tight and fastening off.

Sew hat together.

<b>RS</b>	right side
<b>Sl</b>	slip st
<b>Sm</b>	slip marker

<b>St st</b>	stocking stitch
